EXHIBITOR GUIDE TO REDUCING WASTE

The Brewers Association and The Venetian Las Vegas strive to send as little material as possible to the landfill.

WHAT YOU CAN DO: REDUCE WASTE

- Use the facility recycling receptacles during move in/out and run of the show
- Minimize packaging
- Use only products that are recyclable
- #1-#7 plastic are all recyclable
- Bring only what is anticipated for attendees
- Provide information on a reusable drive or through a QR code

SMART EXHIBIT DISPLAY DESIGN

- Create signs and banners that are reusable or can be recycled
- Print handouts on a post-consumer recycled content paper using soy or vegetable based inks
- Use energy efficient lighting for displays
- Turn off booth lighting, monitors, and equipment overnight

TRANSPORTATION CONSIDERATIONS

- Use local vendors when possible to reduce transportation impact.
- Use local public transportation, walk or bike when possible. Visit: https://www.venetianlasvegas.com

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED:

- helium balloons
- hazardous substances or items including a hazardous substance

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE DISCOURAGED:

- foam-core signage or styrofoam
- signage that cannot be recycled or reused
- plastic bags
- glass

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE ALLOWED INTO THE VENETIAN BUT MUST BE REMOVED AT THE END OF THE EVENT

- vinyl banners
- electronics
- furniture
- equipment
- carpet, carpet scraps and carpet padding
- plaques or trophies
- pallets (store if needed)

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RECYCLABLE AND MUST BE PLACED INTO THE PROPER RECEPTACLES

- clean cardboard boxes and signs
- plastic bottles, cups & containers
- aluminum & tin cans
- paper, newspaper, magazines
- paper towels &napkins
- paper, newspaper, magazines

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE COMPOSTABLE AND MUST BE PLACED INTO THE PROPER RECEPTACLE

flatware, plates and cups
